E-TICKETS

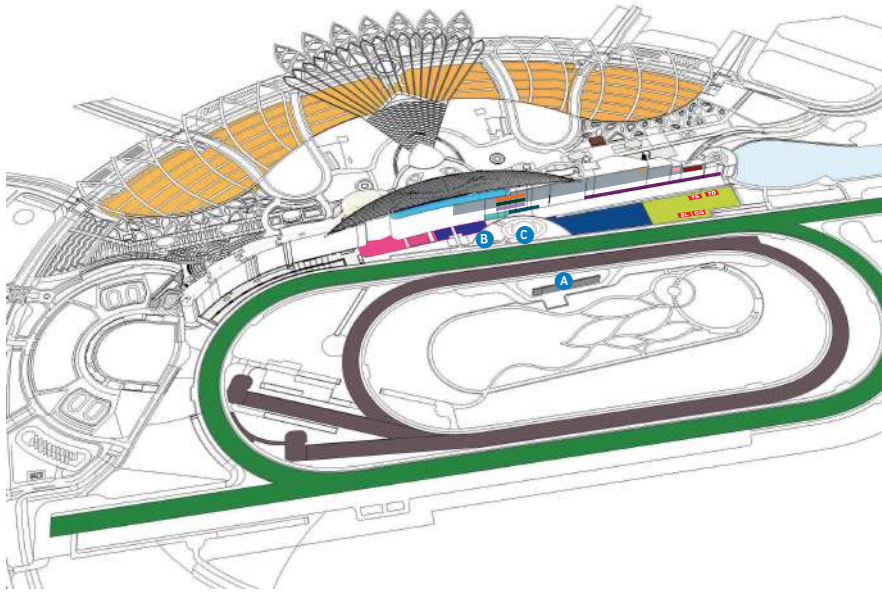
- Hospitality e-tickets must be printed at home in full colour (no black and white)

- Apron Views ticket holders entering through Gate 1 are not required to print their tickets and do not need to display them
- General Public ticket holders entering through Gate 3 are not required to print their tickets and do not need to display them

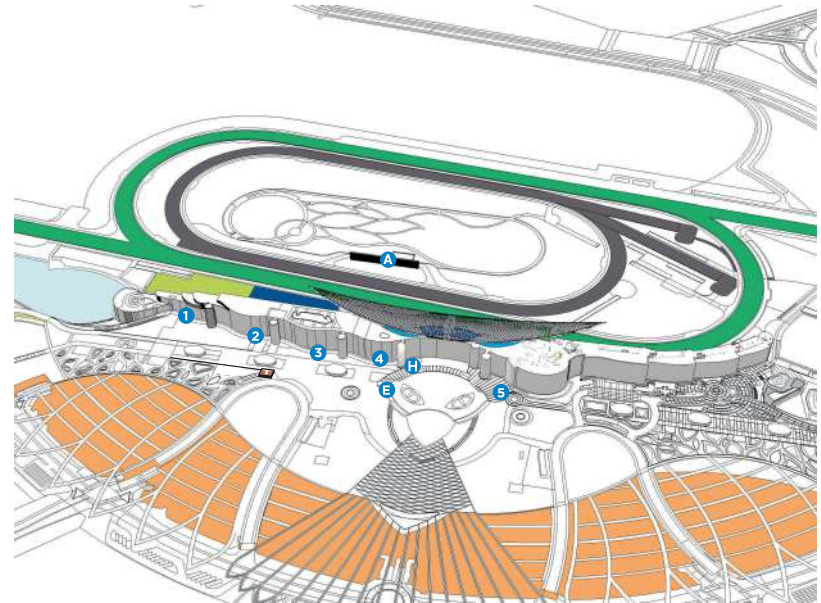

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TICKET SALES OFFICE

CHILDREN'S ACCESS POLICY

- Children 2 years old and below can enter the venue free of charge (no ticket required) when accompanied by a ticket-holding adult.
- Kids and youth between 2 and 12 years of age receive a 50% discount on regular rates in food and beverage packages only. Please contact our Ticket Sales Office for further information.
- Security and ticketing staff may ask for proof of children's tickets (2-12 years of age). Please keep those handy at all times.

Gentlemen (including children 12 years old and above)*

Gentlemen are required to wear smart attire or national dress.

Ladies (including children 12 years old and above)*

Ladies are required to wear smart attire or national dress and are encouraged to wear hats. Dresses and skirts should be of modest length, falling just above the knee or longer.

Guests wearing the following will not be permitted in the Meydan Grandstand:

1. Shorts
2. Sportswear of any type
3. Torn or ripped jeans or any other clothing which is torn or ripped even if considered designer fashion
4. Open neck t-shirt and tank tops
5. Trainers (sneakers/sport shoes) or flip flops

Last year, Emirates kick-started its plans to upgrade the entire interior cabins of 120 Airbus A380 and Boeing 777 aircraft – two of the largest commercial aircraft types in service today.

This ambitious project, representing a multi-billion dollar investment to ensure Emirates' customers "fly better" for the coming years, commenced in November 2022. Earlier this year, the first Emirates A380 to be completely refurbished under the airline's US\$ 2 billion retrofit program was deployed on the Dubai-London Heathrow service, operating as EK003.

Over the next couple of years, 120 aircraft, 67 A380s and 53 777s will have completed their facelift. This will see nearly 4,000 brand new Premium Economy seats installed, 728 First Class suites refurbished and over 5,000 Business Class seats upgraded to a new style and design when the project is complete in 2025.

The fully refreshed A380 features Emirates' latest products and interiors across all cabins, including 56 Premium Economy class seats on the main deck, and new colour palettes evident in the carpeting and wall panels. On the upper deck, First and Business Class seats sport Emirates' latest cream-coloured leather upholstery and lighter-toned wood finishing accented with almond gold trims, similar to the airline's 'game changer' product. Emirates' signature ghaf tree motif also features prominently throughout the interiors, including hand-stencilled panels in the First Class Shower Spa.

Emirates' new Premium Economy cabin class, which offers luxurious seats, more legroom, and a service to rival many airlines' business offering, is currently available to Emirates customers travelling on popular A380 routes to London, Paris, Sydney. More customers will be able to experience the airline's new Premium Economy cabins starting from year end, as the retrofit programme picks up momentum.

Emirates Premium Economy is in a class of its own, offering a signature experience unmatched in the industry.

Customers can look forward to a dedicated check-in area for Premium Economy at Dubai International airport, or utilise one of the many convenient self-service check in kiosks in the hall to avoid queues.

Once onboard, customers will immediately notice the quiet luxury in Emirates' Premium Economy cabin. A wood panel finishing similar to Business Class sets the cabin's mood, and each seat is designed to provide optimal comfort and support with 6-way adjustable headrests.



The cream-coloured leather seats have a generous pitch of up to 40 inches, is 19.5 inches wide, and reclines 8 inches into a comfortable cradle position with ample room to stretch out. It also offers calf rests and footrests for additional comfort, in addition to many other thoughtful touches such as easily accessible in-seat charging points and a side cocktail table.

Customers can get comfortable under soft, sustainable blankets made from recycled plastic bottles, and snuggle into the generously sized pillow, both designed uniquely for Premium Economy. They can also refresh themselves with the complimentary amenity kits which come in reusable, sustainable bags, and contain items which are all made with some element of recycled or sustainable materials.



Incorporating elements inspired by Business Class, customers will be welcomed onboard with a welcome drink in fine glassware. During meal service, a selection of generous meals made with seasonal ingredients and regional influences will be served on chinaware, accompanied by stainless steel cutlery wrapped in linen napkin. The drinks menu will include a selection of beverages including premium wines and a sparkling Chandon wine. There are also liqueurs available after meals, with chocolates.

Each seat has a 13.3" screen, one of the largest in its class, to enjoy the unmatched array of up to 5,000 channels of music, movies, TV, news and other content on Emirates' award-winning ice.

On a four-class Emirates A380, the Premium Economy cabin is located at the front of the main deck with 56 seats laid out in 2-4-2 configuration. On the Emirates Boeing 777, up to 24 Premium Economy seats will be installed in a dedicated cabin section between Business and Economy.

In 1968, Longines launched the Ultra-Chron Diver, the first dive watch to be equipped with a high-frequency movement. At the time, Longines had already established itself as a pioneer in high-frequency technology. In fact, the winged hourglass brand created its first high-frequency timekeeping device to measure precisely 1/10th of a second as early as in 1914. In 1959, Longines developed the first high-beat movement for a wristwatch, an observatory chronometer that set new records in terms of accuracy.

The Longines Ultra-Chron's instantly recognizable 43mm cushion-shaped steel case is fitted with a diving bezel that boasts a sapphire insert with luminescent accents. The eye-catching black grained dial features a white minute track with alternating Super-LumiNova®-coated batons and rhodium plated appliques. The original Ultra-Chron logo is proudly applied on the dial and embossed on the caseback. The new Longines Ultra-Chron has a distinctive red minute hand which, like the hour hand, is coated with Super-LumiNova® for optimal legibility.

The new Longines Ultra-Chron will evoke an emotional response from any watch aficionado who is passionate about the iconic timepieces from one of the most innovative eras in watchmaking. It will also win over new enthusiasts who will be thrilled to wear a bit of horological history on their wrists.
