

### **ADMISSION GATES**

Your hospitality ticket must be worn around your neck at all times during the race day, in order to access your designated area.

#### **E-TICKETS**

- Hospitality e-tickets must be printed at home in full colour (no black and white).
- Guest who have forgotten to print the coloured e-tickets can visit the ticket printing station outside Gate 2 or 4 or 5.
- Follow the information on your ticket regarding Gate entrance.
- Collect your lanyard and plastic pouch at the entrance of your designated gate prior to joining the queue for entering the grandstand.
- Always have your ticket visible by wearing it around your neck during the event.
- Apron Views ticket holders entering through Gate 1 are not required to print their tickets and do not need to display them.
- General Public ticket holders entering through Gate 3 are not required to print their tickets and do not need to display them.

#### **ENTRANCE**

Please ensure you follow the Gate entrance written on your ticket. Security check points will be done immediately after the entrance of the gate.

### **TICKET SALES OFFICE**

The Ticket Sales Office is located at Meydan Racecourse and Granstand Entrance, opposite Gate 2, and will be operational from 10:00am to 6:00pm, Monday to Friday.

The Ticket Sales Office will not be operational for tickets/badge/accreditations collection on Dubai World Cup day - March 30.

The call centre will operate as per normal working hours 10:00am - 9:30pm.

#### **CHILDREN'S ACCESS POLICY**

- Children 2 years old and below can enter the venue free of charge (no ticket required) when accompanied by a ticket-holding adult.
- Kids and youth between 2 and 12 years of age receive a 50% discount on regular rates in food and beverage packages only.
   Please contact our Ticket Sales Office for further information.
- Security and ticketing staff may ask for proof of children's tickets (2-12 years of age). Please keep those handy at all times.

#### **HORSE PARADE RING**

For safety reasons, unfortunately no children (0-12 years) are allowed access to the Horse Parade Ring.

#### Please note:

- 1. It is the responsibility of the sponsors, horsemen, invitees and the person booking the tickets to ensure that their guests adhere to the children's access policy.
- 2. Strollers and children's pushchairs are not allowed access to the Meydan Grandstand.
- 3. All children must be accompanied by an adult.
- 4. Dubai Racing Club reserves the right to refuse entry to policy violators.

#### **INFORMATION BOOTHS**

All information booths are located outside opposite Gate 4 and Gate 5 as well, staff will always be ready to answer your queries and assist you with directions. The booths will be open until 10:00pm.

Closed-circuit television monitors will relay coverage to all the facilities at the Meydan Racecourse. The coverage will also be supplemented by the LED screen, which is visible from all areas of the racecourse.

#### **FIRST AID**

First aid stations are located in the concourse of Gate 2 & 4, food court (Mezzanine Floor), The Gallery, Apron Views and Level 3. If there is an emergency, please get in touch with one of the Guest Services staff or the nearest information booth for assistance.

#### **SECURITY**




